Thank you so much for taking my call.

Please use this email as my "Petition" to our wonderful Mayor & City Council. We need to follow suit, aligning with the City of Seattle in protecting our Snoqualmie rental tenants through care.

Mayor Durkin has extended an eviction moratorium beyond the state protection that Governor Inslee provided that is currently set to expire June 4th. This date is right around the corner. Snoqualmie Government Leadership needs to ensure that none of its residents who have been forced to "stay home" due to small business temporary closures, thus currently unable to work, effective June 4th!

This is the reality for Snoqualmie tenant residents who are unable to pay, due directly to COVID-19 causing nationwide mandatory business & service shutdowns. Protection for Snoqualmie that will expire shortly..

With this email, I as your District #8 current Congressional Candidate, am pleading with you to issue an immediate ruling, aligned with Seattle, to preempt the beginning of evictions by the City of Snoqualmie.

I cannot express the dire emergency of this unmet need at this time, since it appears the City of Snoqualmie has not addressed this issue for its rental tenants.
